We had an opportunity to try Omega Lubricants for the printing machines and have pleasure to testify on the following observations:

Omega 670 (SAE 90 & SAE 140): Mixed with equal volumes for Compressors

Compressor Make : Rietchle German Make – Steel Vane Type
Quantity Used : 5 Ltrs
Recommended Oil : MOBIL DTE AA

Observations: The oil has been working fine last eight months with our regular work schedules. The Lubricant viscosity has remained stable and there is no decolonization of the oil and hence reduces carbon build up. The oil is also very stable with consistent heat bearing capacity

Corium 102 – Paint Ink and Varnish Remover

Initially we had certain clarification on the ink remover usage with “**HEIDELBERG**” machines. But it was only after the visit of yours and re-demonstrations of Corium 102, we were convinced on the product usage of the ink remover.
